## 2 Initial Proposed Release Functionality

#### 2.1 High-level Functionality

The following section provides details of the proposed release functionality that is being delivered as part of the Reilly 1.3 release.

#### 2.1.1 Product Backlog Items

94529: Update Yammer functionality to use new connection methods

Microsoft are deprecating the APIs currently used by the NHS.net Connect portal to administer Viva Engage. With the implementation of this backlog item the NHS.net Connect portal has changed the Viva Engage APIs and access methods used. There will be no change in Viva Engage functionality.

• 94530: Update the Teams description field to allow \_ character

As a part of this PBI, the UI and API Validation is updated to include the '\_'underscore character as an allowed character within the description field of a Microsoft Team. The change applies to admin and non-admin Teams' administration across portal.

94589: Turn off Co-pilot service plans when Microsoft365 Copilot Licence is assigned.

When an admin user creates or updates a User Policy where a Microsoft365 Copilot License is assigned, the below applications will be set to 'Off' by default in the tenant after this PBI has been released:

- 1. Copilot Studio in Copilot for M365
- 2. Power Platform Connectors in Microsoft 365 Copilot

#### 2.1.2 Bug Fixes

94531: A non-transitioned user can be added to a user policy owned by a transitioned organisation
 The fix of this bug ensures that an LA is not able to select or view user policies owned by a transitioned organisation, this is applicable through the user details page of a user and aligns the functionality with the User Policy functionality.

Additionally, in the Organisation page while editing the organisation's default policy, an admin user will not be able to select/view the user policies owned by a transitioned organisation.
